### EAEU

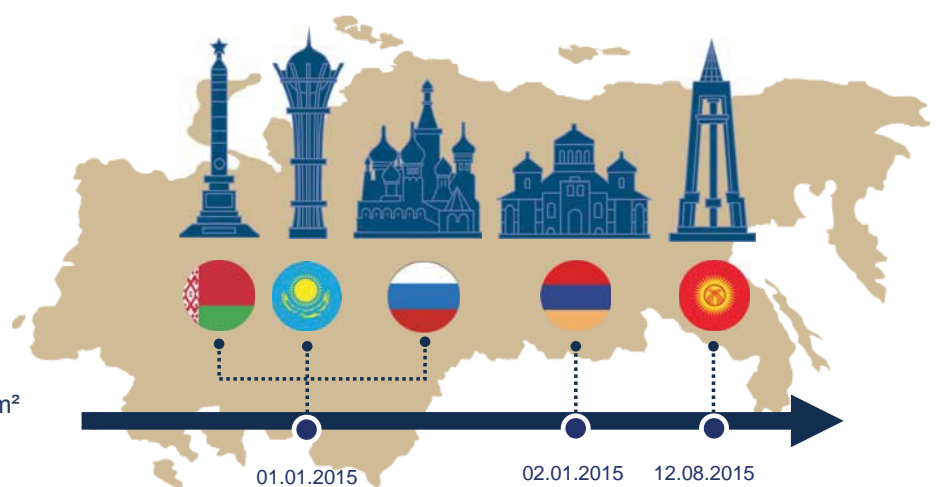
The Eurasian Economic Union is an international organisation of regional economic integration. It has international legal personality.

- Labour

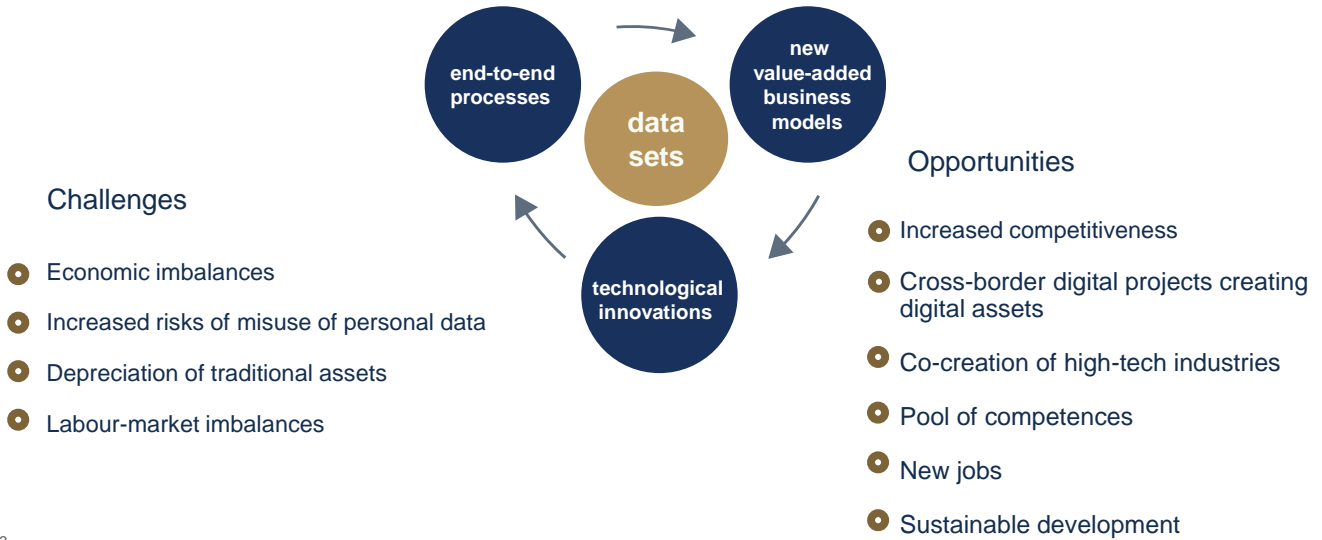

- Digital infrastructure and security

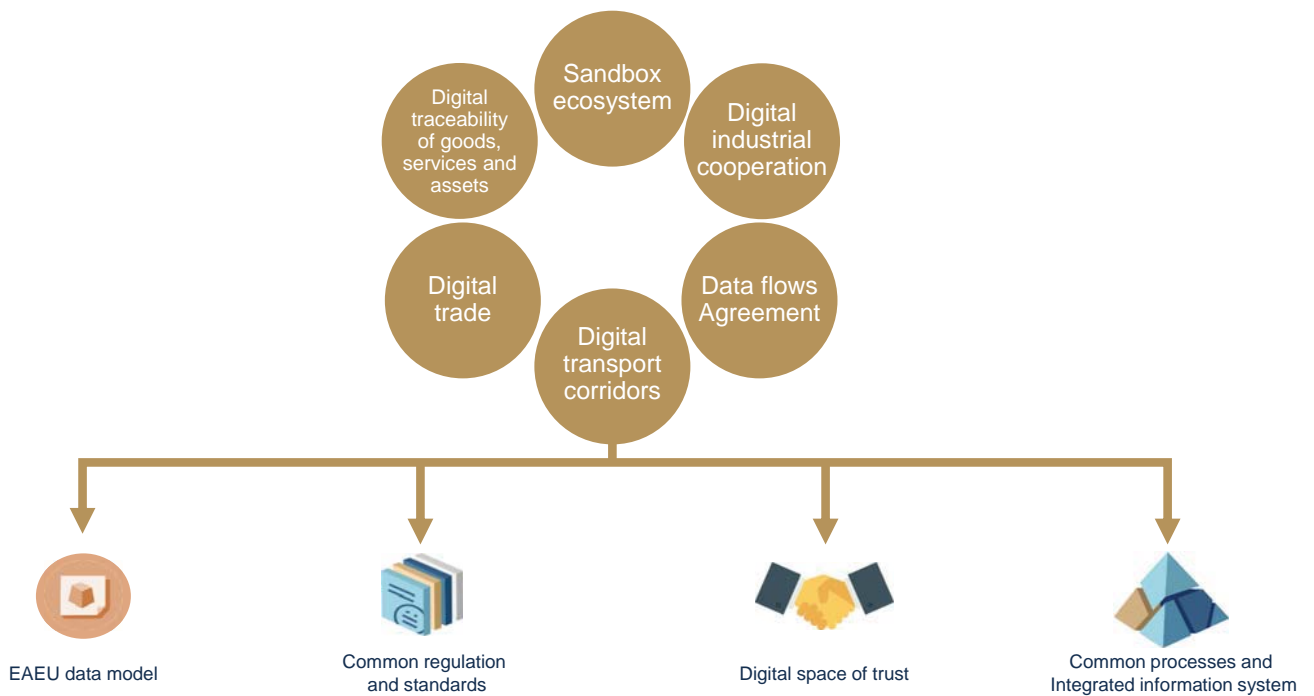
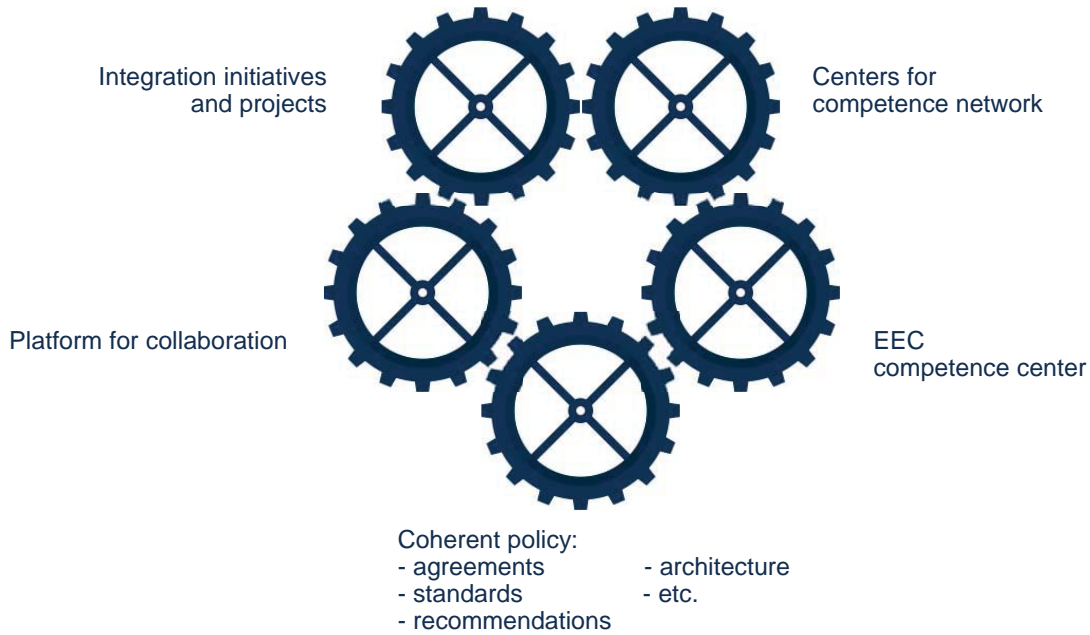
## Potential effects\*:

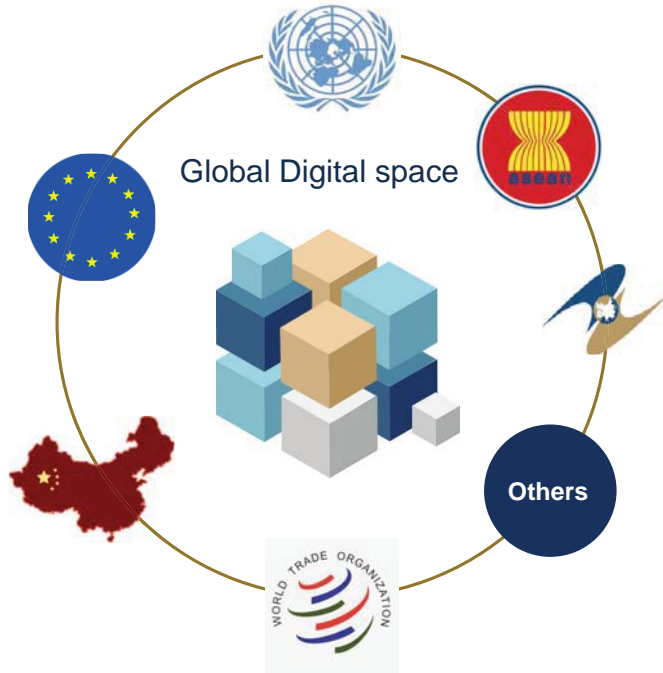
- 1% per annum additional GDP growth
