

  - OSCE Addendum
  - Palermo Convention
  - CoE Anti Trafficking Convention


Share of children among detected victims of trafficking in persons, by gender, selected years

- Ensure effective monitoring of compliance with minimum standards
- Establish innovative funding mechanisms that provide incentives and promote public-private partnership
