For OSCE good governance plays a fundamental role to economic growth, political stability, and security.

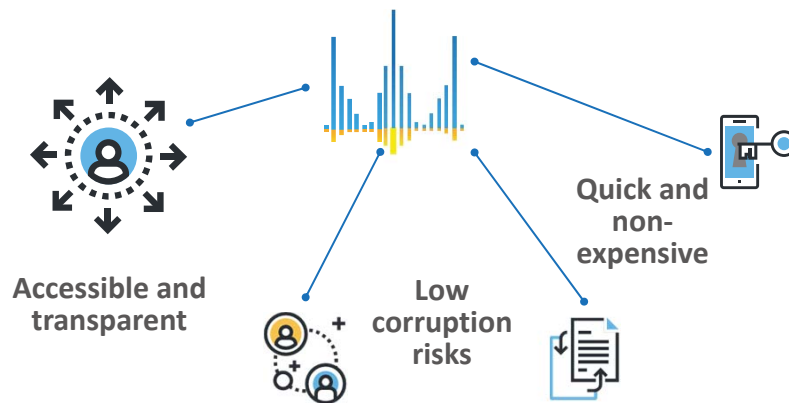
PCU built a strong cooperation with the Ukraine partners from government, private sector and civil society in developing good governance including their efforts against corruption and money-laundering.

History of engagement

- 2010 – The OSCE PCU actively engages in promotion of digital tools as an element of good governance responding to requests of authorities;
- ICT solutions are viewed not as an end goal, but rather as an enabling solution which minimizes corruption risks and hinders fraudulent activities
- PCU zeroes in on those public administration services which are most susceptible to corruption

Select projects

Waste generation management and disposal

- Automation of basic procedures such as e-declaration on waste generation;
- Open register of declarations (disabling chances to meddle with submitted documents without leaving a digital trace);
- New service introduced – waste generation permit issuance (piloted in three regions; more than 10,000 users in 2017)



Select projects

Digitalization of construction activities

- Construction projects go digital (construction project commencement declarations, licensing, permits etc.);
- The procedures are now transparent and straightforward;
- Active promotion of digital services
- stimulate growing number of users



Way forward: digital economy

- OSCE PCU plans to assist national authorities in promoting digital economy principles and developing Ukraine's digital agenda in 2018;
- A study of high growth potential sectors of the national economy and their digitization prospects will be carried out in 2018;
- Digital services will be further promoted.
